

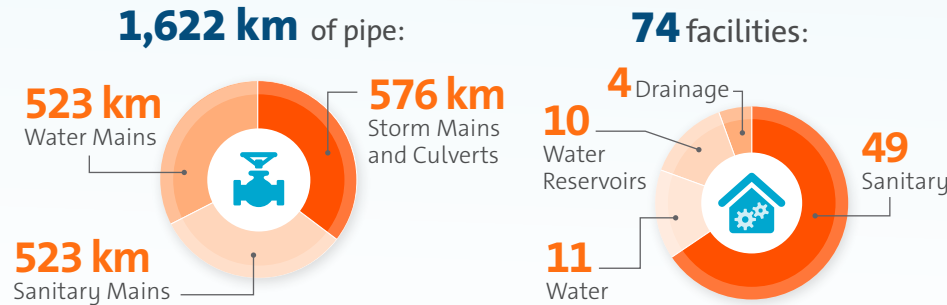


Coquitlam Public Works

Coquitlam's Public Works Division, within the Engineering and Public Works Department, operates and maintains the City's roads, water, sewer and drainage systems, maintains the corporate fleet of vehicles and equipment, manages solid waste services and provides emergency engineering services for water, sewer, drainage and roads 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

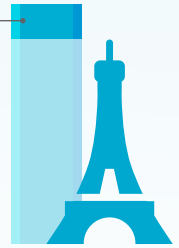
Did You Know?

In north Coquitlam, water is pumped **352m** up the hill.

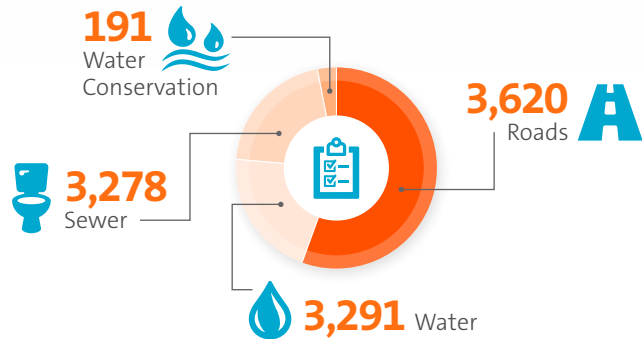
That is **28 meters** higher than the Eiffel tower.



Replacement value of City assets maintained by Public Works: **> \$3 billion**

In 2024 the City's Public Works Division performed at outstanding rates:

10,380 Work Orders and Service Requests Completed in 2024:



+25,500 residential properties received bi-weekly garbage collection and weekly green waste collection from City.

Almost **2,000** mattresses were collected and recycled as part of the Large Item Pick up program.

69% of household waste was diverted from the landfill through recycling and organic waste composting programs.

- 83 km** of Sanitary Sewers Cleaned
- 80 km** of Water Mains Cleaned
- 6,600 km** of Roads Swept

Approximately 450 tonnes of yard waste was picked up from Coquitlam residents for the Spring and Fall Seasonal Unlimited Yard Trimmings Collection program.

- 201 litres** residential water consumption (litres per capita, per day)
- 300 litres** total water consumption (litres per capita, per day)
