Waiver

The repair café (the “**Repair Café**”) is a volunteer operation where visitors can bring in household items for repair, including but not limited to textiles, electronics, bikes, and toys. If the Repair Café accepts an item for repair, any such repair(s) (the “**Repairs**”) are done free of charge and are completed by volunteers.

I acknowledge and agree that participating in the Repair Café involves certain risks and hazards. I understand and further acknowledge and agree that I freely and fully accept the risks and hazards, known and unknown, inherent in the nature of the Repair Café and my participation therein.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in the Repair Café:

1. I hereby waive any and all claims that I have now or in the future against, and release from all liability, the City of Coquitlam, Metro Vancouver, the Greater Vancouver Water District, the Metro Vancouver Regional District, and each of their elected officials, employees, directors, officers, agents, volunteers, and contractors (collectively, the “**Representatives**”), for any costs, claims, damages, demands, actions and causes of action of whatever kind, which might arise from or in connection with my participation in the Repair Café and the Repairs including, without limitation, any personal injury, illness, or death, whether foreseen or unforeseen and regardless of the cause thereof including, without limitation, negligence or partial negligence, breach of any statutory or other duty of care, including under the *Occupiers Liability Act*; and
2. I hereby agree to hold harmless and to indemnify the Representatives from any and all claims made against any of the Representatives by any person, including any claim or action by or on behalf of my spouse or dependents, for damages suffered or costs incurred arising out of or related to my participation in the Repair Café and the Repairs, including, without limitation, any of the matters described or contemplated in item 1 above.

I acknowledge and agree that the Representatives make no guarantees or warranties, whether express or implied, with respect to the Repairs, or any information being provided at the Repair Café.

I hereby acknowledge and agree that in no event will the Representatives be liable for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury or death nor for any loss of or damage (including indirect or consequential damages) that I suffer whether attributable to or arising out of the Repair Café or Repairs, or by reason of any matter or thing done or permitted.
