### Legend

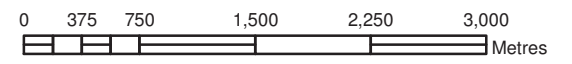
-  Pump Station

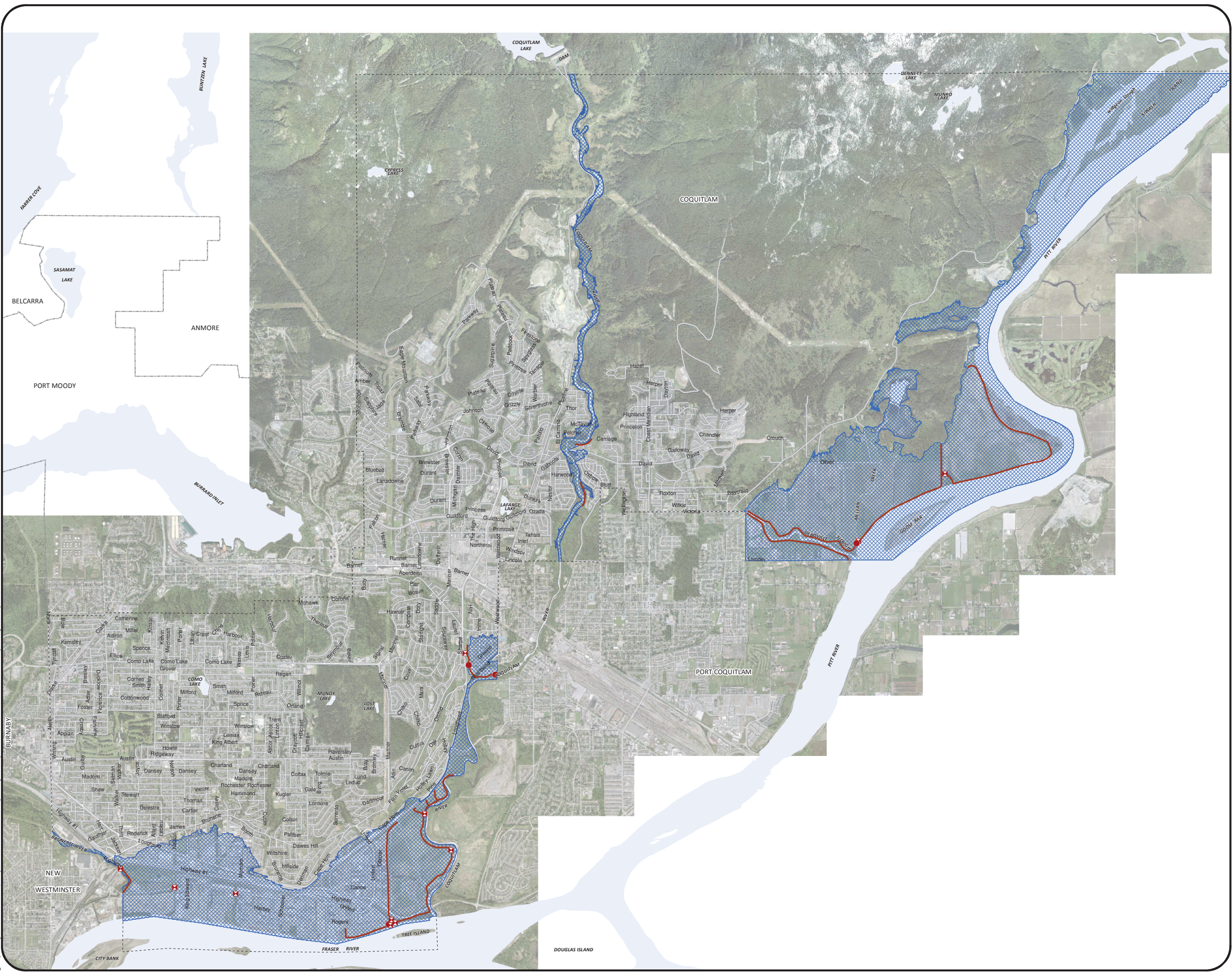
