Notice of Parcel Tax Rolls Authentication

In accordance with Part 7 Division 4 of the *Community Charter*, the City of Coquitlam is undertaking an annual authentication of the Parcel Tax Rolls. Parcel taxes are often used instead of, or in conjunction with, user fees to recover the costs of providing local government services. A parcel tax can only be applied to properties that may receive a particular service. No new parcel taxes have been established for 2026.

The Parcel Tax Rolls will be available for inspection at City Hall, 3000 Guildford Way, Coquitlam, BC, from **Friday, February 13, 2026 to Friday, February 27, 2026**, during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday excluding statutory holidays.

During this authentication process, a person may request amendments to a Parcel Tax Roll. A person who owns a parcel included on a Parcel Tax Roll may request that the roll be amended, but only in relation to the person's own property, for one or more of the following reasons:

- There is an error or omission respecting: a name or address on the Parcel Tax Roll, the inclusion of a parcel, the taxable area or the taxable frontage of a parcel;
- An exemption has been improperly allowed or disallowed.

If no amendment requests are received by **February 27, 2026**, the Parcel Tax Rolls will be considered to be authenticated. Amendment requests that cannot be accommodated by City staff will be heard by the Parcel Tax Roll Review Panel.
