Park Events Fire Safety Guidelines Food Vending Vehicles

Event organizers are responsible for the following submission, regulations and safety requirements for food vending truck vehicles in City parks.

- 1. A business licence is required.
- 2. The vehicles shall meet the requirements of Coquitlam Fire/Rescue Operational Guideline OG 34. This will be verified during the vehicle inspection process.
- 3. Propane cylinders and tanks shall be secured to the vehicle and located in compliance with the BC Safety Standards Act and pursuant regulations.
- 4. Temporary electrical power installations, including generators, shall be proper gauge, rating, be protected from weather and vehicular traffic and be restricted from public access.
- 5. Tents and awnings associated with the vehicle shall be listed as conforming to ULC-S109, "Flame Tests of Flame-Resistant Fabrics and Films."
- 6. The operator shall comply with other applicable City Bylaws.
- 7. An inspection of the mobile food vending vehicle or trailer by our department shall be arranged at least 14 days prior to the event.

It is the responsibility of event organizer to comply with all requirements of this guide, the BC Fire Code, the Fire Services Act and regulations, the City of Coquitlam Fire Prevention Bylaw 3712, 2005 and all other applicable federal, provincial and municipal statutes, regulations and bylaws. Fire/Rescue may at any time inspect the premises for compliance. Failure to maintain compliance may result in the commencement of enforcement action.
