





# OAKDALE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK – WHAT WE HEARD


Throughout the month of May and into early June, 2021, the City engaged with the public on the Oakdale Transportation Network Update (OTNU). This project proposes a revised transportation network for the Oakdale neighbourhood in order to shift the proposed collector route further south, eliminate the need for the Kemsley-Jefferson connector and to create a transportation network that is more feasible to build, with less of an impact on the neighbourhood overall.

## The public engaged in a variety of ways.






**We asked,** “how supportive are you of the proposed revisions to the bike routes and greenways network?”
