


Updating the Vision for Maillardville!

Maillardville Neighbourhood Plan Update Timeline

Phase 1:	<i>Discovering</i> – evaluate existing conditions and assets (Spring 2009)
Phase 2:	<i>Visioning</i> – develop a vision and create plan options (Summer/Fall 2009)
Phase 3:	Planning – evaluate plan options and select preferred option (Winter 2010)
Phase 4:	Adopting – develop updated Neighbourhood Plan and Implementation Plan for Council's consideration (Spring 2010)

What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan is a detailed vision for a particular neighbourhood developed through extensive consultation with the community. If defines land uses, possible densities and other related policies. A Neighbourhood Plan defines the type and location of housing and commercial buildings in the neighbourhood, identifies natural and recreation areas, plans for needed community facilities, and outlines pedestrian and cycling networks.

What will the Update Achieve?

The updated Maillardville Neighbourhood Plan will outline a vision for the area that will help guide change over the next 20 years for this important community of Coquitlam. The planning process provides an opportunity for the community to explore:

- The recognition of strengths and challenges within the Maillardville community.
- The creation of a range of housing choices that will be needed now and in the future to address local housing issues such as affordability and choice. The provision of housing choices will help meet the needs of a diverse and changing population and enhance neighbourhood character.
- The expansion of more transportation choices for existing and future residents and businesses. Making transit, walking and cycling easier to use will increase livability and help reduce impacts on air quality and green house gases.
- The continued development of Maillardville into a vibrant, complete neighbourhood that meets the everyday needs of local residents.
- The enhancement of the capability and attractiveness of Maillardville's employment areas to create more jobs for Coquitlam residents.
- The Preservation and enhancement of Maillardville's parks and natural spaces.
