Stoney Creek is an important watershed in Metro Vancouver that crosses through Port Moody, Coquitlam, and Burnaby. Each organization and all private property owners need to do their part to protect this valuable part of our community.

Coquitlam's Actions

Investigate

- Inspect pipes – 2019 to early 2021
- Flow monitoring – 2020 to ongoing
- Inspect manholes – late 2020 to Jan. 2021
- Fog testing – Jan. 2021
- Dye testing – March 2021, Jan. 2022 to March 2022
- Inspect laterals – Feb. 2022 to Nov. 2022

Rehabilitation, replacement, and mitigation

- Rehabilitate manholes – Jan. 2021, Oct. 2021 to April 2022
- Resolve cross-connections – summer 2021
- Replace sewer mains and services – summer 2021, summer 2022
- Rehabilitate sewer mains, manholes, and services – Oct. 2021 to Nov. 2022
- Implement proactive response plan – summer 2021 to ongoing
- Rehabilitate services - TBD

Ongoing and related actions

- Flow monitoring - ongoing
- Creek water quality monitoring – Feb. 2021 to ongoing
- Grant application – submitted Jan. 2022
- Replacement sewer mains, manholes, and services – ongoing by developers
- Private sewer connection grant funding – ongoing

Actions by Others

Metro Vancouver

- Flow monitoring – 2020 to ongoing
- Evaluate diversion – 2021 to April 2022
- Stoney Creek trunk sewer design – summer 2021 to 2024
- Wet weather pricing – 2022 to ongoing
- Stoney Creek trunk sewer replacement – 2025 to 2028
